Directions

From the North – A1/M1

- Leave A1 signposted Ferrybridge & join M62 East or leave M1 at junction 42 (signposted Hull)
 - Leave M62 at junction 35 (signposted The South)
- Leave M18 at Junction 5 and take 1st exit on to M180 (signposted Scunthorpe)
 - Leave M180 at junction 2, turn left on to A161 (signposted Goole)
 - At roundabout take the exit signposted Crowle/Goole
 - Pass the 7 Lakes and take 4th Exit on left on to Godnow road
 - Follow road for around 200m and the Show is on your left hand side

From the South – A1/M1

- Leave A1 at junction 35 and join M18 North or leave M1 at Junction 32 (signposted Hull)
 - Leave M18 at junction 5 and take 3rd exit on to M180 (signposted Scunthorpe)
 - Leave M180 at Junction 2, turn left on to A161 (signposted Goole)
 - At roundabout take the exit signposted Crowle/Goole
 - Pass the 7 Lakes and take 4th exit on left on to Godnow Road
 - Follow road for around 200m and the Show is on your left hand side
